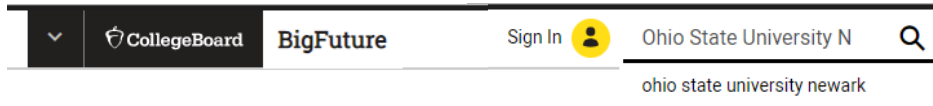


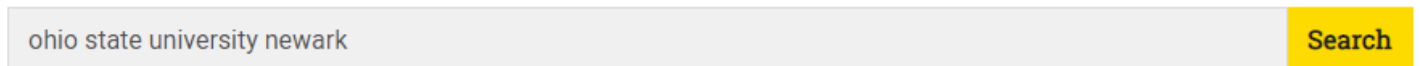
Big Future College Search Admission Requirements


