Apply for free at cotc.edu/apply. Some programs may have additional requirements.
Contact Admissions at cotc.admissions@mail.cotc.edu or 740-366-9222 with any questions.
Check your personal email (the one you used to apply) for an official communication from COTC on how to set
up your COTC email account and your myCOTC student portal. You should receive an email and a letter with
instructions on how to retrieve your username and set up your myCOTC student portal. Once you have your
student email set up, check your COTC email daily for important information.
Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. COTC's school code is: 011046.

Sign your Financial Responsibility Agreement located in your myCOTC student portal.
You will be registered for COTC's online orientation. Complete the online orientation at your earliest
