

How to Print a Student Aid Report (SAR)

*Notes: You will need Student's FSA ID and Password. You may want a flash drive to save your SAR.

1. Go to www.acalltocollege.org and click on "Helpful Links"
2. Click on FAFSA, which will take you to <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/afsa>.
3. Click on returning user and log in

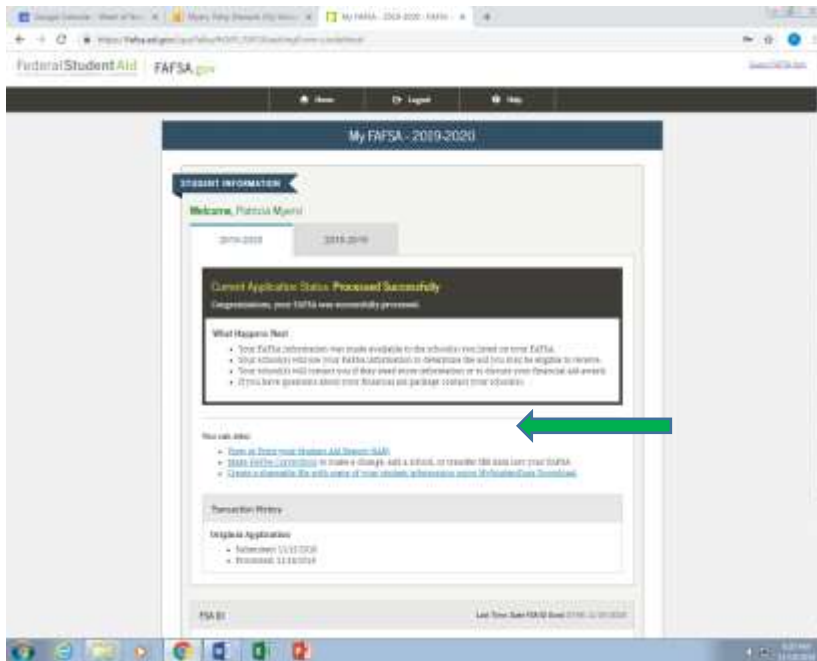


4. Enter Log In. The student must log in with their FSA ID.

8. You can then print out your SAR, be sure to print out all 5 pages. It may be a good idea to save your SAR to a flash drive in case you need to access it at a later date.
